before he can hear people cry

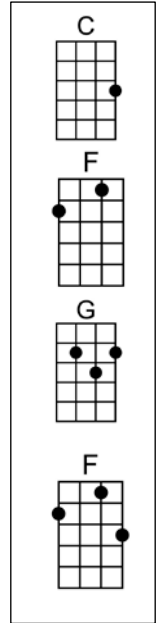
