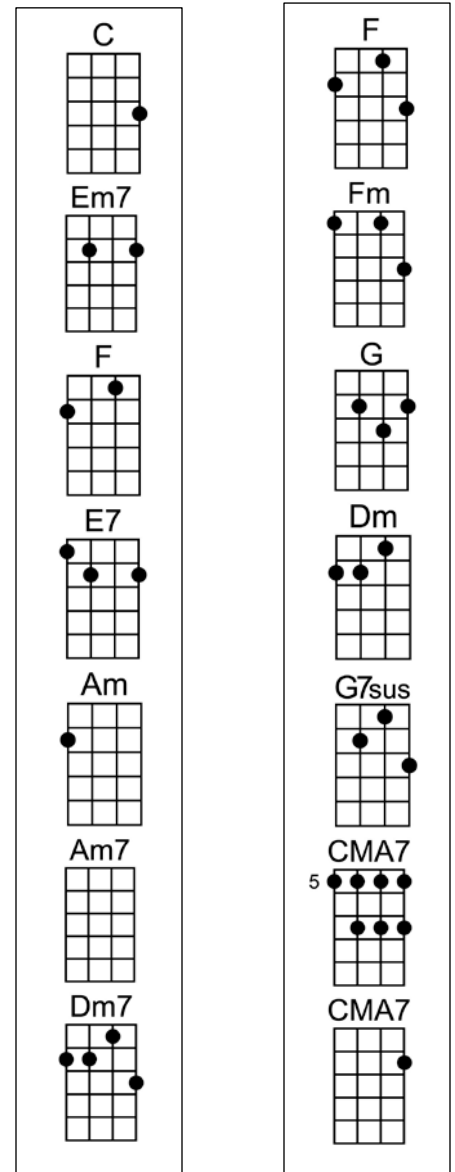

Each chord in the sequence
F Fm C Am Dm G Am gets 1 measure (4 beats). The end of middle part
F Fm C Am7 Dm7 G7sus also get 1.
All other chords get 2. C at end gets 1.
